Camp Sertoma - Through the continued support of the Binghamton Sertoma Club, Camp has continued to expand and includes: main dining hall, inground swimming pool, activities cabin, horseback riding, stables and corral. The Sertoma Club is currently considering a multi year plan to remodel and expand Camp's main dining hall and has contributed nearly \$93,000 to date on that project alone. Camp Sertoma now serves approximately 900 boys and girls annually.
